Pinot Grigio, Natale Verga, Vento, Northern Italy

notes of figs, almonds and pears in the mouth. This light and dry wine is versatile enough to be served by itself or with fettuccine alfredo, lemon chicken

Dusky Sounds Sauvignon Blanc 2021, NZ

Pale straw. Lifted notes of fresh grapefruit, kiwi fruit and nettles. The fresh and concentrated fruit flavours, lively acidity gives the wine its crisp, mouth-watering finish

Red Wine by the Glass

Marques del Puerto, Rioja Crianza 2018

A beautiful union of fresh strawberries, candied blackberry, pleasant pastry notes and toasty undertones on nose and mouth. a dense palate with the presence of ripe tannins

Paul Jaboulet Aîné, Parallele 45 Rouge, Côtes du Rhône, 2018

The tannins are still very present, with finesse and elegance. Beautiful notes of red fruit and spices develop, leaving a beautiful length and freshness on the finish, all very well balanced.

Rose Wine by the Glass

Eden Sauvage, Les Maitres Presqu'île de Saint-Tropez

A well-made rose in classic Provence style, pale, delicate, fresh, balanced and very easy to enjoy.

Whispering Angel

The aroma of a bouquet of fresh flowers, surrounded by strawberries, the flavor was accentuated by the presence of cherries and other red berries, with a clean refreshing finish.

La Jarra Prosecco, Brut DOCG – Organic

Super fresh, juicy, sherbet and lovely bubbles. This fully-sparkling example of Prosecco is pure and bone dry with gentle yet enticing orchard fruit aromas. The palate has a lovely soft, full texture with a touch of peach on the finish and great balance

Cavicchioli Prosecco “1928” D.O.C.G 125ml

Bubbles, not too Heavy, is not super dry, Floral Honey Suckle notes up front, toasty and hints of Marmalade, pear and apple with a Mineral Finish

Champagne

Veuve Cliquot, Bruit, Champagne, France, NV

Fine and persistent bubbles. Delicate yet complex, fresh, well-balanced with hints of citrus. Well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours. The fruit progressively emerge to reveal a finely balanced champagned displaying great length on the finish

Louis Roederer Cristal Brut, Champagne, France 2008

The wine has an intense and elegant aroma with notes of barley biscuits, plum chutney, ripe lemon peel and fine spices. The mouthfeel is saline, taut yet at the same time stratified with layers of and lemon citrus notes along with an iodine sensation while the finish is sharp and full.

Rose Champagne

The Cuvée Léonie Brut Rosé is an ode to the succulence of red berries. To the eye, pale pink and salmon hue. To the nose, intense aromas of fresh fruit, characteristics of Pinots and floral notes. On the palate, notes of fresh-picked red fruits with a subtle spiciness.

WHITE WINE

Pinot Gris 2013, Dry River, Martinborough, New Zealand

\$250USD/\$668ECD

Gorgeous golden colour and a rich nose of pineapple, honey, peach, and caramelized apple (like tarte Tatin!). It's medium-dry but the sugar is balanced by acidity and plenty of alcohol. It's almost like Gewurtz - there is so much fruit and Turkish delight! It is drinking beautifully now but I mightn't wait too much longer.

Villa Wolf 2014 Gewürztraminer, Germany

The invigorating freshness of Villa Wolf's Gewürztraminer is an unusual change from often duller, flabbier versions. While not deeply complex or concentrated it's floral exuberance and crisp peach and pear flavors are refreshing and quaffable

Domiane Weinbach Gewürztraminer, Cuvee Theo, 2014 France

Fascinating bouquet. Ripe, pure, fine. Perfumed and spice but subtle aromas of peel of grapefruit and orange, mandarin, spices and tea. Deliciously pure, subtle, lovely fruit expression - more orange on the palate with gentle spices and excellent balance of acidity. Real elegance and long finish. Funky

Barton & Guestier Vouvray 2016, France

Pale straw with green highlights. Great nose of subtle white flowers mixed with white fruits A lovely and intense wine with floral notes, peach and pear flavors.

Chablis Premier Cru Vaillions Moreau N Audet, 2015, France

Zingy. Lemony, very fruit and mineral driven, with a straight forward taste backed by aroma of fruit, balanced fruit and wood flavours, dry yet complex great with Seafood

2016 Clusel-Roch Condrieu Verchery, France

\$140USD/\$375ECD

Intense, with nectarine, peach and green almond notes bursting forth, backed by anise and melon rind accents on the finish. Wet stone and cracked pepper aromas lead the way in this medium-bodied, crisp white that bucks the appellation's trend of lushness and ripeness.

RED WINE

Heitz Cellars Zinfandel, Napa Valley 2013 USA

\$90USD/\$240ECD

This wine has a puckering sensibility of tannin on entry but settles in the glass to show a fresh core of strawberry, black cherry, cedar and soy. The oak is buttery and spicy, good at playing a supporting role to the density of mountain-grown high-toned fruit

Zonnebloem Shiraz, Stellenbosch 2018 South Africa

\$70USD/\$188ECD

Classic with lots of spiciness and black pepper. Deliciously plummy with a spicy, lingering aftertaste. Excellent enjoyed on its own or served with red meat, venison, casseroles and stews as well as spicy kebabs, roasted pork and wild mushroom dishes.

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
